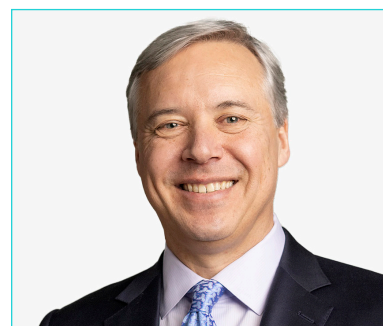


Horacio Rozanski
